

RING EXCHANGE VOWS

- 1) (Bride/Groom) _____, this ring is a token of my love. / I marry you with this ring / with all that I have and all that I am.

(Groom/Bride) _____, I will forever wear this ring / as a sign of my commitment / and the desire of my heart.



- 2) (Bride/Groom) _____, I give you this ring / as a symbol of my love and faithfulness / and as I place it on your finger, / I commit my very heart and soul to you. / I ask you to wear this ring / as a reminder of the vows we have spoken / on this, our wedding day.



- 3) I give you this ring. / Wear it with love and joy. / As this ring has no end, / neither shall my love for you. / I choose you to be my (wife/husband) / this day and forevermore.



- 4) (Bride/Groom) _____, as I place this ring on your finger, / may it always remind you of my never-ending love, / and may it always remind me / of the precious treasure I have in you. / Wear this ring with joy, / for your love has made me complete.



- 5) This ring I give you / in token of my love and devotion, / and with my heart / I pledge to you all that I am. / With this ring I marry you / and join my life to yours.



- 6) (Bride/Groom) _____, please wear this ring / as a symbol of the vows I have spoken, / and let all who may see it / know of the deep love I have for you.

7) (Bride/Groom) _____, I give you this ring / as a symbol of my love for you. / Just as this band encircles your finger, / may you always feel encircled by my love.



8) (Bride/Groom) _____, our love is more precious than this diamond / and more enduring than this band of gold. / I place this ring on your finger / as a symbol of our love / and the vows we have spoken here today.



9) (Bride/Groom) _____, I give you this ring / as a sign of my commitment and the desire of my heart. / May it always be a reminder / that I have chosen you above all others / and from this day forward / we shall be united as husband and wife.



10) This ring I give in token and pledge / as a sign of my love and devotion. / With this ring I thee wed. (*Traditional*)



11) With this ring I thee wed / and from this day forward / I give thee my pledge / with tenderness and care / and trust in God. (*Traditional*)



12) With this ring I thee wed. Whither thou goest I will go and where thou lodgest I will lodge; thy people shall be my people and thy God my God. (*Traditional, first version*)

With this ring I wed you. Where you go I will go and where you live I will live; your people shall be my people and your God my God. (*Traditional, second version*)

NOTE: Groom's Ring Exchange Vows may be the same as or different from Bride's Ring Exchange Vows.
